## About SP

The Singapore Polytechnic was first established on 27 October 1954, with the passing of the Singapore Polytechnic Act. It was the first polytechnic to be set up in the country. Its main campus at Dover Road occupies a 38-hectare site.

The Polytechnic's mission is to be a future-ready institution that prepares our learners to be life ready, work ready and world ready.

## Graduate Output

A total of 5,845 students graduated in the 2015/2016 academic year. At this graduation ceremony, a total of 5,500 graduands will receive their diplomas, advanced diplomas, specialist diplomas and certificates. These comprise 5,007 from the full-time and 493 from the part-time courses (419 are from the new MOE CET framework). Another 345 from the new MOE CET framework graduated in November 2015.

With this year's batch of graduates, the Poly would have produced close to 190,000 graduates to date.
