TUITION GRANT SCHEME

Introduction

The Tuition Grant Scheme was introduced by the Government to help students with the costs of tertiary education in Singapore. Singapore Citizens will be automatically awarded a Tuition Grant without the need for application if found eligible. There is no service obligation required of Singapore Citizens.

2 Tuition Grant (inclusive of any GST subsidy) are granted to students on Tuition Grant Scheme based on the nationality of the student and disbursed to the institution directly in accordance to the scheme.

3 **The new Academic Year (AY) 2017 Tuition Grant amounts are under review.** The Tuition Grant amounts provided by the Government in AY2016 for students pursuing the diploma programmes at Singapore Polytechnic (SP) is S\$16,700.

Declaration of Tuition Grant Eligibility

4 Students who are Singapore Citizens (including those holding Government scholarships) will be required to complete the Tuition Grant Declaration Form which is available at SP. For students who are below 21 years, your parent/guardian will be required to sign on the form. All students must submit the completed form to the Admission Office on your registration day. Students who do not submit the completed form by the stipulated deadline will be charged the non-subsidised fees, which the polytechnic will advise separately.

Subsidised Tuition Fees

5 Tuition Grant recipients at SP will pay the subsidised tuition fees as set out at its website.
