## INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

- 1. Students would need to complete Part A of the Colour Vision Test Form and bring it to any medical practitioner registered in Singapore or optometrist registered with the Optometrists & Opticians Board (OOB) with their NRIC / Passport:
  - Students may visit any of the SATA CommHealth clinics listed on this page. The clinic will submit the completed Colour Vision Test Form to SP directly.
    - Alternatively, students may visit a private clinic, their family doctor or Optometrist registered with OOB. Once students have received the completed Colour Vision Test Form, they are to submit to Singapore Polytechnic (SP) through <a href="http://enrolment.sp.edu.sg">http://enrolment.sp.edu.sg</a> > Upload Admission Documents.
- 2. Students are required to bring along their glasses.
- 3. The Colour Vision Test fees will be borne by the students.
- 4. Students with "Partial Colour Vision Deficiency" or "Complete Colour Vision Deficiency" result for their Colour Vision Test may encounter difficulties in meeting the requirements and expectations for the courses they have been offered. These students would need to email to SP Admissions Office at <u>contactus@sp.edu.sg</u> immediately so that SP may try to arrange for a course transfer. Students should include the following information in their email:
  - Email Subject: Colour Vision Deficiency
  - Student's full name and SP Admission Number.
  - The name of the course that was initially offered to him / her; and
  - Indicate either "Partial Colour Vision Deficiency" or "Complete Colour Vision Deficiency".
- 5. Students who have questions on the Colour Vision Test can call SP at 6775-1133 during office hours (Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 5.30pm).
