## **First Choice Applicants**

Singapore Polytechnic was once again the first choice among school leavers during the 2006 Joint Admissions Exercise. Of the 22,022 who applied for polytechnic courses,

7,600

or 34.5% chose the institution as their first choice.

## **Total Student Enrolment**

For academic year 2005–2006, Singapore Polytechnic took in 5,437 new students. Of this intake, 4,660 were full-time students whilst 777 were part-time students. This brought the total enrolment to

## **Foreign Student Enrolment**

A total of 1,213 foreign students were enrolled in full-time courses. They formed

## **Male-Female Enrolment**

In academic year 2005–2006, male students formed 64.7% of the total student population. Majority of them were enrolled in the engineering and maritime courses. School of Business and School of Chemical & Life Sciences saw a higher proportion of female students.

A total of 5,274 students graduated from Singapore Polytechnic in academic year 2004–2005. They comprised 4,858 students who graduated from diploma courses and 416 from advanced, specialist and post-diploma courses.

School of Electrical & Electronic Engineering had the highest output with a total of 1,536 graduates.
