Welcome to Media, Arts & Design School Orientation Programme!

This is a **compulsory orientation** programme, comprising an **online application for your pre-specialisation modules**, and **in-campus programmes** on Tue 9/4/24 and Thur 11/4/24 (you must attend both days).

The programme will provide you with important and useful information on your course of study, academic and administrative matters. You will also get to meet your personal tutors and classmates.

Some Useful Information to Prepare you for in-campus FOP

MAD School Reporting Date, Time and Venue:	Tue, 9th April 2024, 10 am @ respective MAD School venues As you enter SP from Dover MRT Gateway, you will be greeted by our friendly MAD Student Leaders (with placards) who will direct you to MAD School until 10.00 am. Please arrive early as it takes about 15 mins to walk from Dover MRT gateway to your FOP venue.
What to Wear:	Tee-shirt and long pants/jeans with covered shoes. You may choose to bring a sweater or cardigan in case some venues get too cold.
What to Bring:	 Student Matriculation Card – You will need this for entry to SP. Get ready your Student Matriculation Card for tapping in to enter SP at Dover MRT gateway. If your card is not ready, use the right-most gantry lane or show proof of your acceptance. 1-2 food items for donation for SP Cares Mobile phone Personal water bottle Coloured markers(any type, medium and broad) for class activities.


