

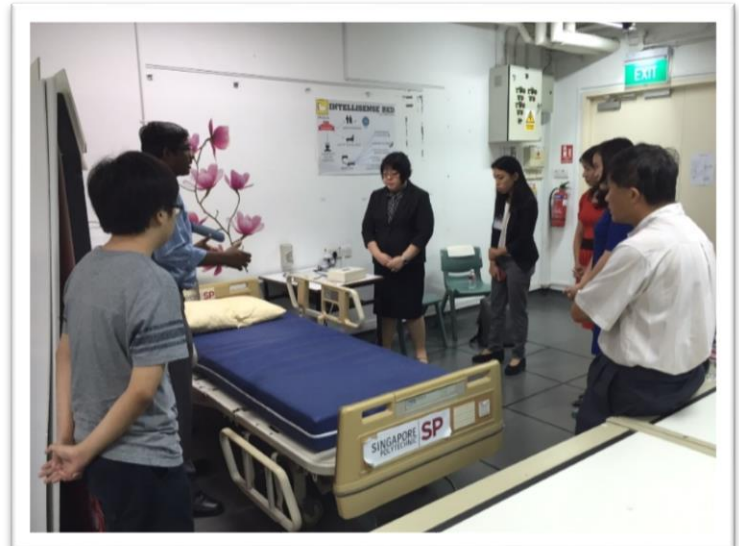

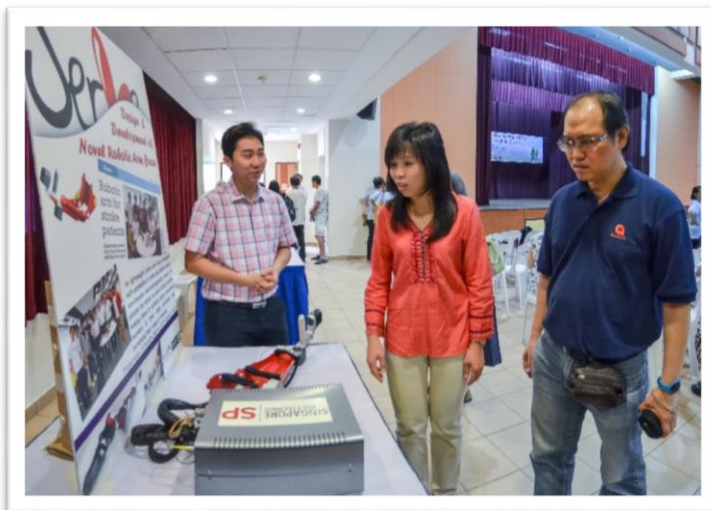
## Partnership with Eastern Health Alliance
