

## **SINGAPORE POLYTECHNIC SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS**

1. This is a private pool and is meant for SP staff & their immediate family members, SP students, SIT (UOG & TUM) staff & students, and authorised users only.
2. Alumni with valid SP alumni card are allowed to use the pool during non peak hours: weekdays 9am to 3pm; weekends 4pm – 9pm only.
3. Produce your ID when requested by staff or lifeguard on duty
4. Children below the age of 12 shall be accompanied by adults
5. Children deemed to be incompetent in swimming are not permitted in the main pool unless accompanied by an instructor or parent who is competent in swimming
6. Users must wear proper swimming costume/trunks when they are using the pool
7. Avoid excessive use of water
8. Shower is mandatory before entering the pool
9. Bathing at the poolside shower is strictly prohibited
10. Do not run at the decks of the pool
11. Do not spit within the premises
12. Urination in the pool is strictly prohibited
13. Do not litter
14. No pets are allowed
15. Smoking is strictly prohibited
16. Swimmers are to swim at their own risk
17. Face masks, flippers, paddles and snorkels may be used with permission from the DSD
18. Users shall make good or bear the full cost of replacing any broken or damaged equipment, property or facilities
19. No unauthorised instructors may be brought in for any swimming lessons or other water-based activities without prior approval
20. No one shall cause the water in the Pool to be unfit for swimming by the use of soaps or other substances which may pollute the water
21. No games or activity that may endanger or cause injury to others are allowed in and around the pool area.

Failure to abide by the above mentioned rules will result in loss of privilege to use the swimming pool

No one shall hold Singapore Polytechnic liable for any loss of life, property or injury that may occur within the swimming pool.
